

Record of decisions taken by the Street Scene, Parks and Open Spaces Portfolio Holder

Lancashire County Council – Public Realm Services

On 25 January 2018, the Service Director People and Places submitted a report seeking approval for the continuation of the delivery of services within the public realm on behalf of Lancashire County Council.

Decision taken

The Street Scene, Parks and Open Spaces Portfolio Holder agreed that

- the council continue with the agreement to undertake all services currently provided as referred to under section 4.5 of the report for the financial years 2018/19, 2019/20 and 2020/21.
- any changes to the agreement be the subject of a future report.
