

# NOTICE OF ELECTION

## UK Parliamentary Election for the Wyre and Preston North Constituency

1. An Election is to be held for of a Member of Parliament to serve Wyre and Preston North.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the Acting Returning Officer, Electoral Services Office, Civic Centre, Breck Road, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire, FY6 7PU during the times stated below.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer at the Electoral Services Office, Civic Centre, Breck Road, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire, FY6 7PU on any day after the date of this notice, on Monday to Friday 10.00 am to 4.00 pm (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4.00pm on Thursday 14 November 2019.
4. If the election is contested the poll will take place on 12 December 2019.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by midnight on Tuesday 26 November 2019.
6. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom.  
The Acting Returning Officer has also given his consent to the payment of a deposit by means of a debit card or the electronic transfer of funds.
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Civic Centre, Breck Road, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire, FY6 7PU by 5.00pm on Tuesday 26 November 2019.
8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Civic Centre, Breck Road, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire, FY6 7PU by 5.00pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Civic Centre, Breck Road, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire, FY6 7PU by 5.00pm on Thursday 12 December 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5.00pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5.00pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
