Town Centre Boundaries Review September 2017 (Addendum January 2018)

Introduction


The Publication draft Wyre Local Plan was published on 23 September 2017. Policy EP4 – Town, District and Local Centres defines the extent of town centre boundaries. Policy EP4 is supported by evidence contained in the Town Centre Boundaries Review (September 2017).

As part of the six week public consultation on the Publication draft Wyre Local Plan, a representation was received from Garstang Town Council that sought to extend Garstang town centre boundary to include the Aldi supermarket located on Moss Lane.

Garstang Town Centre Boundary (January 2018)

In considering the Garstang Town Council representation, Wyre Council has reconsidered the proposed Garstang Town Centre boundary in relation to the Aldi supermarket site only. The Aldi supermarket is located adjacent to the proposed town centre boundary (September 2017). The Aldi supermarket includes pedestrian linkages with Booths supermarket that is located within the town centre boundary. It is therefore consider appropriate to extend the town centre boundary to include Aldi supermarket and its curtilage.

The map below identifies the revised Garstang town centre boundary that now includes the Aldi supermarket. No further amendments are proposed to the town centre boundaries within Wyre borough and the January 2018 addendum should be read alongside the Town Centre Boundaries Review published in September 2017.
