



Notice of Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

In accordance with The Representation of the People Act 1983 each local authority is required to carry out a review of Polling Districts and Polling Places in its area. Wyre Council's next review will be carried out from 8 October 2019.

We are looking for feedback on any aspect of polling districts and/or polling places currently used and invite representations and comments from interested persons.

Local political parties, councillors, parish and town councils and neighbouring councils affected by the proposals will be consulted and are welcome to submit written representations during the consultation period. Views are also invited of persons and groups possessing particular expertise in relation to premises or facilities for persons who have different forms of disability.

The consultation period for the review will commence on 8 October 2019 and end on 5 November 2019.

Unlike polling districts and polling places which are fixed by the local authority, polling stations are chosen by the relevant Returning Officer for the election. Anyone wishing to make representations, should, if proposing alternative polling stations provide details of alternative premises that may be used as a polling place.
