



## **Record of a decision taken by the Resources Portfolio Holder**

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### **Asbestos Management Surveys**

On 17 November 2016, the Service Director Performance and Innovation submitted a report asking the Resources Portfolio Holder to approve the use of Lancashire County Council (LCC) Design & Construction surveyors to carry out management asbestos surveys and to update asbestos registers for all council buildings.

### **Decision taken**

The Resources Portfolio Holder gave approval to proceed with the engagement of LCC under the exemption to Contract Procedures contained within the Financial Regulations and Financial Procedure Rules on the grounds that “exceptions may apply regarding the appointment of consultants, including architects, engineers, quantity surveyors, solicitors, barristers and other people providing professional services”.
