

## **Record of a decision taken by the Resources Portfolio Holder**

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### **New Sand Filters at Garstang Swimming Pool**

On 23 February 2017, the Service Director Performance and Innovation submitted a report to the Resources Portfolio Holder asking for his agreement to the engagement of NCF Systems Ltd as the preferred supplier/installer of the new sand filters at Garstang Swimming Pool.

#### **Decision taken**

The Resources Portfolio Holder gave his approval to proceed at a cost of £55,000 with the engagement of NCF Systems Ltd under the exemption to Contract Procedures contained within the Financial Regulations and Financial Procedure Rules on the grounds that exceptions may apply where “goods, works or services are of a specialised nature carried out by only one or a limited number of firms with no reasonably satisfactory alternatives available”.

#### **What were the reasons for the recommendations and what other options were considered and rejected?**

If a decision is “called-in”, the Overview and Scrutiny Committee may decide that the original decision should be upheld or ask the Portfolio Holder to reconsider the decision.

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
