



Record of a decision taken by the Resources Portfolio Holder

Renewal of the Council's Energy Procurement Contract

On 29 June 2017 the Service Director Performance and Innovation submitted a report seeking the Resources Portfolio Holder's approval of the renewal of the Council's energy procurement contract with British Independent Utilities (BIU) for a three year period commencing October 2017.

Decision taken

The Resources Portfolio Holder agreed to the renewal of the council's energy procurement contract with BIU for a three year period commencing October 2017 and that the approval to renew the Council's contract with BIU be dealt with under the exemption to Contract Procedures contained within the Financial Regulations and Financial Procedure Rules on the grounds that exemptions may apply regarding the appointment of consultants including architects, engineers, quantity surveyors, solicitors, barrister and other people providing professional services.

All decisions will be put into effect five working days from the date of publication, unless a decision is "called-in" by any four members of Wyre Council within that period. If a decision is "called-in", the Overview and Scrutiny Committee may decide that the original decision should be upheld or ask the Portfolio Holder to reconsider the decision.

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
