


Science Badge Clouds have names and patterns of behavior that are used to predict the weather.

The Mount was built as an important observation point and even today every weather watcher has a part to play in recording the accuracy of forecasts. Did it rain when it was predicted?


Here are 4 examples of clouds, there are many more so look to the sky and draw what you see ...
