2. A whelk egg case
3. A huge white rock
4. A pebble shaped like a heart
5. A sea snail shell
6. A razor clam shell
7. A rock pool
8. A blue mussel shell
9. A crab
10. A piece of sea glass, any colour
11. A golden pebble
12. A pebble full of holes
13. A sea gooseberry
14. A circle of stones
15. Three blades of giant grass
