## Here's how to make your own Nature Bingo game:

To play Nature Bingo you need first to make a list of about 12-15 nature words. Think about the nature you see from your window, at the Mount Gardens, on the way to school, at the park.

There's nature everywhere so keep your eyes open for ideas.

Once you have your list draw a grid with nine squares and in each square write or draw something from your list

Now cut up your list of words, fold them up and put them in a bowl.

The bingo caller then picks one piece of paper at a time and reads out the nature word. If you have it on your grid, cross it off and keep going till someone crosses off all their squares, they are the winner!
