During Fleetwood's development, the Mount & Pavilion were very important. They were part of a new navigation system, designed by Captain Henry Mangles Denham, sending messages to ships using lights, landmarks & signals

Did you know???

The Wyre Light Lighthouse was the first screwpile lighthouse in the country

Here's how to make your own Mount Message:

First think of a positive message that might brighten up someone's day. Your message could be:

- For someone your age, older or younger
- To cheer up someone feeling sad
- To make someone laugh
- To suggest a fun activity or walk
- Sharing something that helps you feel better
- Or anything you think might help someone feel good

When you've thought of your message it's time to get creative! There are lots of fun ways to make your message, here are a few ideas you might like to try:

- Draw or paint your message on paper
- Write it in pebbles on the beach
- Write in objects you have at home; pens, pencils, shoes, pasta etc.
- Record an audio message
- Write a poem or joke
- Draw a cartoon or picture
- Collage letters & words from old magazines, newspapers etc.
- Write it in the sand
- Write it in chalk on the pavement
