## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLAGNING GINERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1977

MERCHAS the Wyre Borough Council being the appropriate local planning cuthority within the meaning of article 4 of the Town and Country Flanning General Development Order 1977 are of the opinion that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on land at Cleveleys Lancashire known as Royal Hotel Car Park and edged red on the plan annexed hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Flanning General Development Order 1977.

AND WHIPPARS the Council are further of the opinion that development of the said description would be prejudicial to the proper planning of the area and would contribute a threat to the amenities of their area and that the provisions of paragraph 3(b) of the said article 4 should apply to this direction.

NOW THERITORY the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the said article 4 heraby direct that the permission granted by article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Crder 1977 shall not apply to the development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto.

THIS DITION is made in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph (3)(b) of the said Article 4 and shall remain in force until the third day of February 1980 (being six months from the date of this direction) and will then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date.

## THE SCHEDULE

The use of land (other than a building or the curtilage of a building) on not more than fourteen days in total in any calendar year for the purpose of the holding of markets and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use, being development comprised within Class IV referred to in Schedule 1 to the said order and not being development comprised within any other class.


