Lawful basis for processing your data

Processing your data is necessary for the Communications and Marketing Team to perform tasks carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of its official authority in accordance with Article 6(1)(e) of the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR). If you have provided us with special category data (such as details about your health) we will process this under Article 9(2) of the GDPR. This privacy notice provides additional information that specifically relates to this particular service, and should be read together with our <u>overarching privacy notice</u> which provides more detail.

How we process your data

Wyre Council (The Data Controller) will only process and share your personal information to carry out the services which you have requested.

Categories of personal data

In order to carry out these activities we process personal information in relation to:

- Images of people taken via photography or video camera for promotional purposes where permission is obtained.
- Social media identity/information via our <u>social media channels</u>. How we will use your personal data

We use your personal data for the following reasons:

- To seek your views and opinions in consultations and surveys;
- To share council news and important information.

Where has your personal data come from?

The personal information we process is provided by you through contact with us via our website, by email or social media or when consent it given for photography.

How we share your data

We only share your data across the council and with other providers of council services on a need to know basis, in order to provide a good, timely service for you.

We will not disclose your personal information to third parties for marketing purposes

How long we keep your personal data

We will keep your information for as long as it is required by us for the purpose we are processing the data for.

Other than crowds at large events and adults in public spaces, we seek permission from anyone featured in our photography before we use it. We keep the contact details included on our photography consent forms for ten years after which point it will be deleted, the photography will then be archived. Your rights
