This communication is addressed to representors who submitted comments ('representations') at the most recent stage of this exercise. I am now able to provide additional information about progress towards hearing dates and related timetable issues.

Inspector Mark Dakeyne has been appointed to carry out the examination of the Plan and you may recall that he was also engaged for the previous exercise which was adopted in early 2019.

Going forward, I shall use the related Examination webpage to keep representors and other observers informed of latest news and new documents arising as the examination progresses, supplementing these with more direct contact where appropriate. However, I would recommend that you make a note to have occasional reviews of the Examination webpage.
