

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Parliamentary Election for the

BLACKPOOL NORTH AND FLEETWOOD CONSTITUENCY

1. An Election is to be held of One Member of Parliament for Blackpool North and Fleetwood.
2. Forms of nomination for the Parliamentary Election may be obtained at Civic Centre, Breck Road, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire, FY6 7PU from the Acting Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer, Civic Centre, Breck Road, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire, FY6 7PU on any working day after the date of this notice between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm but no later than 4 pm on Friday, 7th June 2024.
4. The required deposit may be made either by the deposit of any legal tender, by means of a banker's draft or, with the Acting Returning Officer's consent, in any other manner (such as electronic transfer of funds).
5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 4th July 2024.
6. New applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Breck Road, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire, FY6 7PU by Tuesday, 18th June 2024. You can register at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Breck Road, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire, FY6 7PU by 5pm on Wednesday, 19th June 2024. You can apply for a postal vote at www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote
8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Breck Road, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire, FY6 7PU by 5pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. You can apply for a proxy vote at www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote
9. New applications for a Voter Authority Certificate must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Breck Road, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire, FY6 7PU by 5pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024.
10. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic
11. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Breck Road, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire, FY6 7PU by 5 pm on Thursday, 4th July 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024.
