Notice is given that on 28 February 2019 Wyre council adopted the Wyre Local Plan 2011-2031.

Subject matter and area covered: The Wyre Local Plan 2011-2031 (the Local Plan) covers the whole of the Borough for the period 2011-2031. It provides the statutory planning framework for the Borough for non-minerals and waste matters. It replaces the saved policies of the Wyre Local Plan 1999 and the Fleetwood-Thornton Area Action Plan.

Examination: The Submission Wyre Local Plan 2011-2031 was submitted to the Secretary of State on the 23 January 2018. An independent inspector was appointed by the Secretary of State to conduct an Examination into the soundness and legal compliance of the Local Plan, including the Duty to Co-operate.

Modifications: The Inspector's Report of the Examination was issued on 1 February 2019. The Report concluded that the Local Plan is legally compliant and, with specific Main Modifications, is sound. The adopted Local Plan incorporates the Main Modifications recommended by the Inspector, together with additional (minor) modifications made by the council that do not materially affect the policies in the Local Plan. Challenge: Any person who is aggrieved by the adoption of the Local Plan may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

a) The document is not within the appropriate power; and/or

b) A procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made no later than six weeks from the date on which the Local Plan was adopted.
