

Town and Country Planning, England The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012

In accordance with Part 2 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 as amended 2015 and 2016, Wyre Borough Council recently consulted on an application made by Myerscough and Bilsborrow Parish Council for the designation of the Barton Area as a Neighbourhood Area for the purposes of Neighbourhood Planning. Following consultation, Wyre Borough Council has resolved (on 31 August 2017) to approve the application and designate part of the Parish as a Neighbourhood Area.

In accordance with the above regulations, in particular Regulation 7(1) the Council must publicise the following information about the designation to bring it to the attention of people who live, work or carry out business in the area to which the designation relates.
