Equality Impact Assessment 2017 Addendum (Main Modifications) August 2018

Introduction

The Publication Draft Wyre Local Plan was published in September 2017. As part of the preparation of the Plan, the council undertook an Equality Impact Assessment of the document (dated August 2017) (ED007).

The Publication Draft Wyre Local Plan is currently the subject of an Examination carried out by an independent Inspector. The council has received the Inspector's Post Hearing Advice – Main Modifications and Related Matters (EL6.003a). As a result of the matters raised, the council has produced a schedule of Main Modifications to the Publication Draft Wyre Local Plan. As with the original document, the council has considered whether or not the modifications policies in the local plan as proposed to be modified have the potential to be discriminatory or have differential impacts on members of our local communities.

Impact Assessment

This addendum to the Equality Impact Assessment considers whether or not the proposed Main Modifications materially affect the original conclusions drawn up in the original 2017 document. The assessment has been conducted on a policy-by-policy basis where there are Main Modifications. As with the initial EqIA (ED007), the assessment is not concerned with site specific allocations.
